On behalf of the Delaware County Chapter of the Pennsylvania Society of Professional Engineers (PSPE), I would like to welcome you back to another new school year, and invite you and your students to compete in the 2011-2012 MATHCOUNTS competition. MATHCOUNTS is a nationwide math competition which offers middle school students the opportunity to use their math skills to win prizes and college scholarships.

By now you should have received packets from the National MATHCOUNTS headquarters containing: your School Handbook 2011-2012, Registration Form, and the 2011-2012 Poster with a math riddle.

The local MATHCOUNTS competition will be held At Garnet Valley Middle School on:

Saturday, February 11th, 2012,

with a snow date of Saturday, February 18th, 2012.

The local first place winners will advance to the State MATHCOUNTS Competition to be held at the Sheraton-Harrisburg-Hershey Hotel. You are invited to send a team of up to four (4) students to represent the school. In addition to or in lieu of a school team, up to six (6) students may compete as individuals from the same school. A maximum of ten (10) students are allowed per school. Although the competition is targeted to the 7th and 8th grade curriculum, 6th grade students are also eligible to compete.

The PSPE Delaware County Chapter is again sponsoring your School Team registration fee of \$90 for the 2012 local MATHCOUNTS competition. This will entitle the School Team to attend the local chapter competition and the opportunity to advance to state and national competitions.

Your completed Registration Form and Individual registration fee only should be mailed to MATHCOUNTS Registration at the address shown on the form. In addition, please fax a copy of your registration form to the attention of Kevin Matson at 610-358-9376 to allow us to process your Team registration fee of \$90 in a timely manner. Shortly after we receive your fax and MATHCOUNTS Registration receives your completed form with Individual registration fee payment, your school competition materials will be mailed to you by MATHCOUNTS National Headquarters.

If registering online is easier for you, we will provide reimbursement for anyone who wishes to use www.mathcounts.org to register. Kindly provide proof of registration status and we will forward your reimbursement.
