Pennsylvania Engineering Foundation Faber Fellowship Guidelines

To assist young engineers in their pursuit of a graduate degree in engineering, the Pennsylvania Engineering Foundation has created a \$2,000 Faber Fellowship. The award will be given annually.

Eligibility Requirements - Applicants must be students who:

- are currently seniors in engineering at an EAC-ABET accredited program
- have taken the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) exam (award is contingent on confirmation of passing)
- have been accepted in a graduate program in engineering at a school whose graduate program is EAC-ABET accredited

Evaluation Criteria - Applications will be evaluated based on:

- grade point average
- passing the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) exam
- internship/co-op experience and involvement in other activities
- faculty recommendation(s)
- ethics essay

Required Application Materials - Applications must include the following:

- Official transcript from an EAC-ABET accredited undergraduate program
- Proof of having passed or taken the Fundamentals of Engineering exam
- Proof of acceptance into a graduate program in engineering at a school whose undergraduate or graduate program is EAC-ABET accredited
- A resume of internship/co-op experience(s) and involvement in extracurricular activities
- Recommendations from faculty members who have taught the applicant (at least two recommendations are required; additional will receive consideration)
- A 500 word (maximum) essay on "The Importance of Ethics in the Practice of Engineering."

Deadline:

Application materials must be postmarked no later than **April 15, 2008**.
