APPLICATION GUIDELINES *Undergraduate*

Grants

The Pennsylvania Engineering Foundation currently administers the following engineering scholarships:

- (2) \$2,000 Pennsylvania Engineering Foundation (PEF) Grants: Undergraduate
- (2) \$1,000 Professional Engineers in Private Practice Grants: Undergraduate
- (2) \$1,000 Harrisburg Chapter PSPE Grants: Undergraduate

PEF, PEPP, and Harrisburg Chapter Scholarships: A check for one-half the amount will be delivered to the student in the fall; a check for the remainder will be delivered to the student for the spring semester, after the student has notified PEF that a 3.0 GPA has been maintained and sent a copy of the fall transcript.

Harrisburg Chapter PSPE Grant: The undergraduate scholarship is available to students in the Harrisburg chapter area – Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Lebanon, Juniata & Perry counties.

Requirements

- Scholarships are one time only grants issued for freshmen attending their first semester in the fall of 2011, at an ABET accredited engineering school in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- Student must be a Pennsylvania resident.
- Minimum SAT Math Score: 700
- Minimum SAT Verbal Score: 600
- Minimum GPA: 3.6

Instructions

1. Answer all questions on the application.
2. Include your SAT scores on your application; attach a copy of the official test report.
3. Include a certified copy of your high school transcript indicating your courses for the first semester of the 12th grade.
4. Clearly indicate on the transcript all courses that are included in the high school "honors" or "advanced placement" programs, any courses completed from a college or university curriculum for which high school credit is earned, and credits earned from a special industry program.
5. The school Guidance Counselor or Principal needs to complete the appropriate portion of application, including a description of the curriculum and grading system used, and indicate on the transcript those courses in progress for the first semester of the 12th grade.
6. Participating chapters of the Pennsylvania Society of Professional Engineers (PSPE) may have scholarships available in addition to those administered by PEF. For scholarship deadlines in your county, contact the Scholarship Chair on the enclosed list. Return completed applications to the Scholarship Chairperson in your area.

Student Checklist

- q Test scores are at least the minimum score indicated on the application
- q Student has a minimum 3.6 GPA
- q Counselor or principal has signed application
- q Student has signed application
- q Student has applied to an ABET accredited school in Pennsylvania
- q Certified transcript is included and signed by the counselor or principal with explanation of the grading system and curriculum
- q Student essay
- q Student kept a copy of the application for their records
